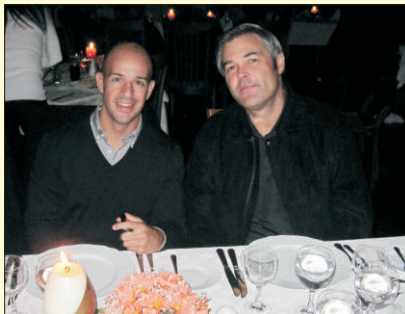
The conference concluded with a dinner no one will soon forget. The group was first taken by bus to the foot of one of the
